### Context and objectives of the workshop

Since the beginning of 2024, FAO has been supporting Greater Amman Municipality (Jordan) in tackling food losses and waste, in collaboration with the Milan Urban Food Policy Pact (MUFPP) and the NGO Let's Food. This initiative intends to serve as a crucial entry point for advancing urban food systems transformation.

This initiative promotes peer learning between Greater Amman Municipality and Milan Municipality (Italy), with both cities engaging in an exchange of perspectives and experiences throughout the year. The NGO Let's Food has facilitated these exchanges and provided support to Amman Municipality in developing a food waste management action plan. This plan was informed by a participatory assessment of food losses and waste conducted in Amman, with insights gathered during two workshops involving local stakeholders.

The outcomes of this initiative are essential for operationalizing food system transformation at the city level, drawing on lessons learned from Milan's experiences.

To build on this momentum, FAO and its partners invite you to participate in the final international workshop titled "Together in Action on Food Losses and Waste: Shared Learning of Practices and Experiences Towards Sustainable and Inclusive Agrifood Systems Transformation."
