The “flavescence dorée” workshop 2024 is aimed at sharing updated information about the disease situation and management in the European viticultural areas where the disease is present and/or spreading.

The workshop will focus on insect vectors, epidemiology, detection, plant-host interaction, management and new technologies and it will be hosted In Italy in Verona (Veneto region) from Thursday 25th to Friday 26th, January 2024. The scientific program will include keynote speeches and oral presentations.

The workshop will be followed by a technical update in Italian to share the practical experiences in Italian viticultural areas.

Scientific contributions

English will be the official language of the workshop. Contributed presentations will be published as abstracts in a dedicated abstract book that will be available to delegates and online. The abstract submission implies that the authors agree for its dissemination in the workshop web page and in the abstract book. The presenting author must be registered to the workshop.

The abstracts must be submitted as MS Word document (.doc .docx) through the online form available in the workshop website or by [clicking here](#). They should not exceed 350 words or 2,500 characters including spaces: references should be limited to two; figures and tables are not accepted. A reference template is provided online ([click here](#)). All the abstracts will be reviewed by the Scientific Committee.

Oral presentations

The scientific program will include oral and short oral presentations in agreement with the decision of the Scientific Committee. The abstract acceptance will be communicated by email before **29th December 2023**. The final program will be published online in the workshop website after **15th January 2024**.

Instructions for presenters: Microsoft PowerPoint for MS Windows (*.ppt or .pptx) will be used for presentations, which must be in the **16:9 format (wide screen)**. Only fonts included in the basic version of MS-Windows 10 will be available; some examples of the most common fonts are: Arial, Calibri, Times New Roman, Verdana. The use of fonts not included in Windows 10 can cause wrong formatting of the presentation. Meeting organisers will load all the presentations on the computer that is used in the conference room. **Presenters will NOT be allowed to use their own laptops.**

Registrations

All the participants are requested to **register online** by clicking the button on the right or with the link available in the workshop website. Please fill one form for each participant (including accompanying persons). The student category includes also people holding non-permanent positions. Before 10th January 2024 accompanying person can book the social dinner for € 50.

The registrations paid after 10th January 2024 do not include the social dinner that can be booked upon availability at a price of € 60, so we suggest you to pay your registration before this deadline.

The registration fee includes: admission to the scientific sessions, book of abstracts, workshop-related material, coffee breaks, affiliation to IPWG.

The social dinner is included only for the registrations paid before 10th January 2024, after this date it can be booked only on-site at the registration desk upon availability.

Confirmation of registrations: the registration will only be valid upon the receipt of the full payment by the Organizing Secretariat within the deadline. The confirmation of the registration will be sent to participants by e-mail only after the amount will be visible in the bank account, which may take a few days. 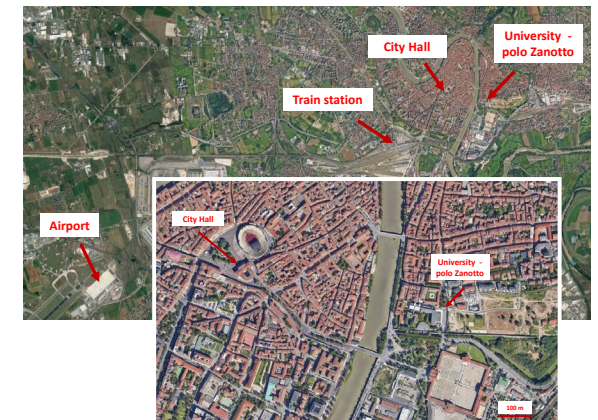

How to get to the workshop

By plane: the international airport Valerio Catullo of Verona-Villafranca (www.aeroporto.verona.it) is located about 12 km from the city center. A shuttle bus service "Verona Airlink" connects the airport to the Verona Porta Nuova train station in about 15 minutes and it operates daily, at 5.15 am, 6.10 am, 6.30 am, 6.50 am then every 20 minutes until 10.50 pm. From the railway station you can follow the "by train" instructions.

By train: the main railway station is Verona Porta Nuova, at the intersection of the Milan-Venice line with the Rome-Brenner line. There are frequent, direct and high-speed connections with the main stations of northern Italy, Florence and Rome (www.trenitalia.it) (www.italotreno.it). From the station you can reach the workshop location by taxi or by public transport (bus n. 11, 12, 13) in 10 and 20 minutes respectively (www.atv.verona.it).

By car: Verona can be easily reached by taking the Serenissima A4 motorway, Milan-Venice, Verona Sud exit, or the Modena-Brennero A22 motorway, Verona Nord exit. The nearest parking lot to the workshop location is Parking "Centro", near the Monumental Cemetery.
